The *Health Evidence Bulletins - Wales* (1) Project act as signposts to the best current evidence across a broad range of evidence types and subject areas.

The Cardiovascular Diseases Bulletin was published in 1998 (2). At present work on an updated Cardiovascular Diseases bulletin, under the new title Coronary Heart Diseases, is underway to provide support to the National Service Framework for Wales (NSFW) on Coronary Heart Disease (Improving Health In Wales - Tackling Coronary Heart Diseases in Wales: implementing through evidence (3). Both Cardiovascular Diseases and Healthy Living (4) have informed this implementation plan. The statements in the bulletin and the evidence-based standards, on which this implementation plan is based, have been derived from a systematic summary of the evidence found through a formal literature search across a wide range of sources and critically appraising the literature using internationally accepted methods.

The result of a survey of the views of health practitioners who will be involved in implementing the NSFW and the resulting influence on the final content and format of the Coronary Heart Diseases bulletin will be described in a poster presentation.

This collaboration between information professionals, public health physicians, and a multidisciplinary team directly involved in patient care is an example of thinking globally - acting locally, and the finished bulletin will hopefully be a useful resource world-wide.
