





# Aims of academic medical libraries

Aims of academic libraries are regulated by the Act of Higher Education. Libraries are obligated to meet needs in three main areas:

- Research
- Didactic
- Services

# Problem conferences

In the beginning of the 80. an idea of yearly medical libraries conferences was born. The conferences were to analyze and solve the problems, unify procedures and search for new forms of co-operation.

The first conference, dedicated to exchange of information on holdings, took place in Gdansk at December 6., 1981.

# Computerization of science information services


Automating Polish medical libraries has been started in computerizing science information systems. At the initial stage the efforts were headed towards

- provision of basic bibliographic databases
- as well as electronic periodical catalogs
- building of own information sources e.g. library holdings and bibliography of Polish medical publications
- cataloging and linking to valuable sources of medical information

In 1996 the first library published its WWW pages over the Internet. They are used to present general information, on-line catalogs, lists of new acquisitions, subscription lists, news, services and catalogs of links to relevant electronic information sources.

# doc@med

- electronic document delivery service based on the stocks of Polish medical libraries.

The system enables supply of electronic form of journal articles. At the present, the catalog of available journals consists of over 2200 titles from 5 libraries. The catalog is automatically searched, then the order is generated and sent to the appropriate library. After the article is scanned into a PDF file, it is sent to the ordering library or straight to the patron. Orders are to be delivered within 48 hours.


