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Evidence Based Librarianship / Evidence Based Information Practice: Definitions

1. Evidence Based Librarianship seeks to improve library practice by utilising the best available evidence in conjunction with a pragmatic perspective developed from working experience in librarianship. The best available evidence might be produced from quantitative or qualitative research designs, although EBL encourages more rigorous over less rigorous forms of evidence when making decisions.

2. Evidence Based Librarianship is a means to improve the profession of librarianship by asking questions, finding, critically appraising and incorporating research evidence from library science (and other disciplines) into daily practice. It also involves encouraging librarians to conduct research.

3. Evidence Based Librarianship is an approach to information science that promotes the collection, interpretation and integration of valid, important and applicable user-reported, librarian-observed, and research-derived evidence. The best available evidence, based on user needs and preferences, is applied to improve the quality of professional judgements




Definitions: short version


...the best available evidence, moderated by user needs and preferences, is applied to improve the quality of professional judgements...
