

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Fundamental goals of university studies

Undergaduate education shall provide the students with:

- the ability to make independent and critical assessments
- the ability to define, formulate and solve problems independently
- the capacity to adjust to changes in their working life

- search for and evaluate knowledge at a scientific level
- follow the development of new knowledge
- exchange knowledge, also with individuals who have no specialist knowledge in the area



Nursing research in nursing practice

Essential for nurses to

- understand their profession
- explain phenomena that must be considered in planning nursing care
- predict the probable outcomes of certain nursing decisions
- control occurrence of undesired outcomes
- initiate activities to promote desired client behavior (compliance)



Nurses as consumers of nursing research

The nurses needs for knowledge

- suitable technology
- correct language (proper terminology)
- producers for searching literature
- use of the information
- sorting the information
- communicate the information to others
- selecting the most useful findings for their patients







Information use

Intellectual activity

- read the literature
- reflect upon gathered information
- compare different sources
- analyze
- examine and assess the relevant findings
- make synthesis of the study
- create meaning from the gathered information



- Exercise task

- Short lecture. Groups of 12-15 students
- Information searches with supervisors

- Examination task

- 3 hours lecture. Approximately 50 students
- Information searches with supervisors

Examination task

- > Selection of case study

- Literature searches
- > Drawning of document searches in a search diagram
- Critical review of their own results
- Write up in a short paper



Examination task

- Resons and reflections up on choosen information sources search strategies and choice of articles.
 Relate to a theory
- Reflect upon problems and possibilities
- > Reflect upon benefits
- Write a reference list
- Repeat another group's search strategy
- Present and discuss their experiences on the examination seminar.

- Motivations and reflectations in documentation
- The reference list
- The presentation at the seminar
