Frequently researchers will disregard the issue of efficiently storing and organizing scientific articles retrieved from Medline or from other databases. The relevance of bibliographic references in the research process makes it advisable to adopt appropriate management tools.

Software for storing personal bibliography has been available for a long time, although it does not appear to be extensively used in our Network of Research Institutes. For this reason since January 2007 BIBLIOSAN has decided to officially adopt one such commercial software. The chosen product has technical characteristics allowing Web use, with the possibility to share information with other researchers, hence promoting cooperation. To encourage its use BIBLIOSAN planned a nation-wide teaching plan aimed at involving the largest possible number of researchers in the Network Institutions.

**Work objectives**

In this work we will report on the organizational effort to implement the use of the software.

**What is Bibliosan**

This is the library network of the Italian Biomedical Research Institutions strongly fostered by the Ministry of Health. It includes 55 institutions which share their own informative resources together with the others and with them participate in their acquisition. One these resources is the software used for personal management of bibliographic references.

**Adopted organizational solutions**

- 1) Choice of a Software with web interface and stored information sharing.
- 2) Educational courses for librarians in each and every institution, who in turn will teach their own users.
- 3) Courses for the final users held within peripheral organizations and included in the Italian Continuous Medical Education program.

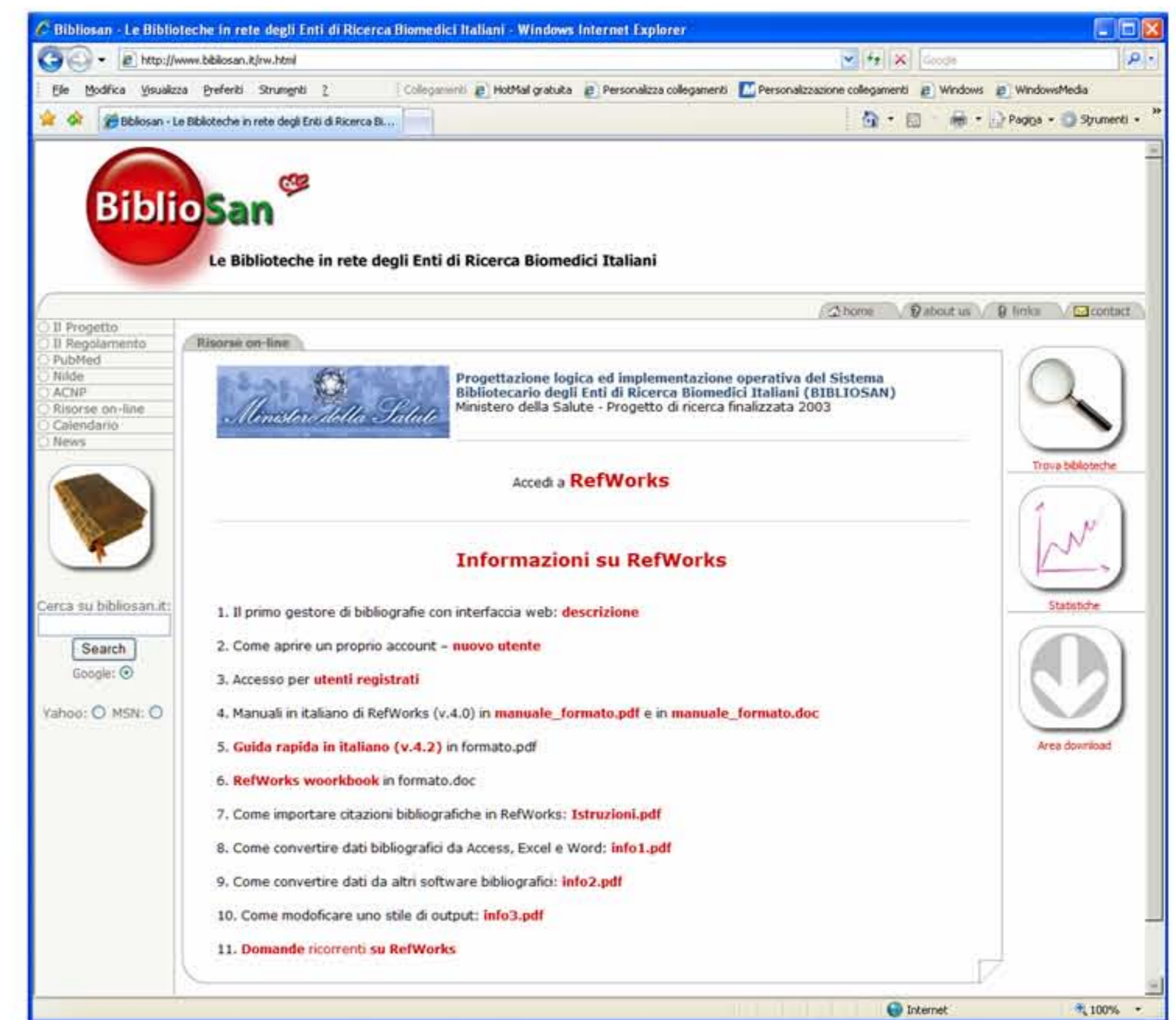

4) Awakening Scientific Directors on the importance of this tool and the need to aid its diffusion and use.

5) Software availability and tools for its use: publication of the link to the software, the registration form and the tutorials for the introduction to its use on the BIBLIOSAN website.



6) Realization of a DVD based on the video-taping of the first educational course, to be handed out to past and future course participants.



7) Creation of a work force in order to further investigate the power and enforceability of the software to Bibliosan.

- More than 600 registered users of the software
