■ Russian activist claims Estonia cyber attack

The member of a pro-Kremlin youth group has claimed to be behind the attacks on Estonia, which took down its internet network.

An activist with a pro-Kremlin youth group said he and his friends were behind an electronic attack on Estonia two years ago that paralysed the NATO state's internet network.

Ex-Soviet Estonia blamed the Russian government for the attack at the time, though Moscow denied involvement. The incident prompted the NATO military alliance to review its readiness to defend against "cyber-warfare."

Konstantin Goloskokov, an activist with Russia's Nashi youth group and aide to a pro-Kremlin member of parliament, said he had organised a network of sympathisers who bombarded Estonian internet sites with electronic requests, causing them to crash.

He said the action was a protest against the dismantling in 2007 of a Soviet-era monument to the Red Army from a square in the centre of Estonia's capital Tallinn. The removal prompted two nights of rioting by mainly Russian-speaking protesters.

"I was not involved in any cyber-attack. What I did and what my friends did was no kind of attack, it was an act of civil disobedience, absolutely legal," 22-year-old Goloskokov told Reuters in a telephone interview.

"Its aim was to express our protest against the policy of soft apartheid which has been conducted by the leadership of Estonia for many training and the climate of thick that the dismonthing of

The Chinese government has once again prevented its citizens from accessing video-sharing service YouTube.

Following reports that access to the site had been cut, a spokesperson from parent company Google confirmed to vnunet.com that YouTube was indeed being blocked.

"We do not know the reason for the blockage, and are working as quickly as possible to restore access to our users in China," the spokesperson said.

Google declined to comment further on whether it was speaking with the Chinese government about the matter.

The block is reported to have stemmed from a recent round of videos depicting protests and police reactions in Tibet. According to the BBC, one particular video depicted a policeman beating Tibetan monks and protestors.

This is not the first time that YouTube has run foul of the Chinese government.

Similar Tibetan protest videos last year led the country to block domestic access to the site.

Civil rights groups have long been pressuring China to relax its controls on web content for sites such as YouTube and Wikipedia.

YouTube has also been the target of censorship campaigns from governments in Burma and Turkey over contentious video clips.

### Scotland teaching agency LTS launches iTunes U

I'm pleased to see that former colleagues in <u>Learning and</u>
<u>Teaching Scotland</u> have managed to get their <u>LTS iTunes U</u> site opened, following our friends at the <u>Open University</u>. Scotland heads out as the first iTunes U provider of professional



development material podcasts for those working with 3-18 year olds.

It's not been an easy journey. In 2005, on joining LTS to head up their Modern Languages work, I challenged the organisation to get podcasting (audio) the entire Scottish Learning Festival contents, and video as much as possible. Four years on we're still not able to access good quality recordings of everything, despite the costs of doing so being derisory and the long-tail interest being high - just take a look at the figures viewing what might be conceived as obscure education topics on the Slideshare site I created for the event.

We also had a challenge getting more audio and video material out in subsequent years through the now-defunkt <u>Connected Live</u> site, intended to be an evolution of the print magazine with media-rich addition to the limits
