### what is NECOBELAC


NECOBELAC is a Project funded by the European Commission within the 7<sup>th</sup> Framework Programme in 2009.

## results to be achieved

NECOBELAC intents to create a network of health institutions in Europe and LAC countries to spread know-how in:

- scientific writing
- open access publishing

through *ad hoc* training programmes addressed to all stakeholders in scientific communication for the safeguarding of public health.

NECOBELAC will help developing a cultural change in the information production and dissemination through a shared strategy taking into account both international standards and local needs. It will use existing infrastructures. The network will continue operating after the project term to improve the quality and quantity of scientific publications and develop new collaborations between Europe and Latin America.

# partners and their commitment

The Project involves six partners (academic and scientific institutions) from Italy, UK, Spain, Portugal, Colombia, and BIREME-PAHO-WHO countries. They all have a sound experience in information production and networking initiatives.

They share a common interest to raise awareness on the principles of good practice among all stakeholders in the scientific information chain: authors, editors, publishers, information professionals, funding agencies, institutions, learned societies and general public.
