Title: Should era of the impact factor end in Hungary?

More and more bibliometric indicators emerge beside the impact factor, and a few of them are promising performance indicators. The aim of the study is to show briefly, but clearly the position of Hungarian biomedical periodicals focusing newest bibliometric measure numbers – like the recent enhancements of Journal Citation Report Web, Hirsch-index, Eigenfactor and SCImago Journal & Country Rank algorithms –, and to demonstrate the similarities and differences of these indicators with some examples. There are unified and well-structured web pages behind the newly appeared indicators, and some of the new numbers are presented in the well-known databases (Web of Science, Scopus) as scientific measures. The impact factor has too high prestige in Hungary – especially on the biomedical area, and the new bibliometric measure numbers could mean alternatives for the reformation.
