Research Structure in Hungary

- 
- Hungarian Academy of Sciences with 48 research institutes and other institutions (eg. libraries)
 - 71 institutions of higher education
 - College of the Directors of University Libraries in Hungary
 - Hungarian Research Fund

Open Access in Hungary

- 14 journals in DOAJ
- 11 repositories in ROAR / OpenDOAR
- Three signatories of the Berlin Declaration
- Funder mandates
(OTKA, Wellcome Trust, NIH, EC, EUA, EURAB)

IPR regulations

- National level
 - Copyright Act
Libraries are allowed to digitise documents from their collection
 - Government regulation
Open access of doctoral theses
- Local level
 - Intellectual Property Rules at Universities
 - Lack of self-archiving policies

- HUNOR: HUNgarian Open Access Repositories
 - University libraries and the Library of the Academy
 - Aims: representation, coordination
 - National OA portal: www.open-access.hu

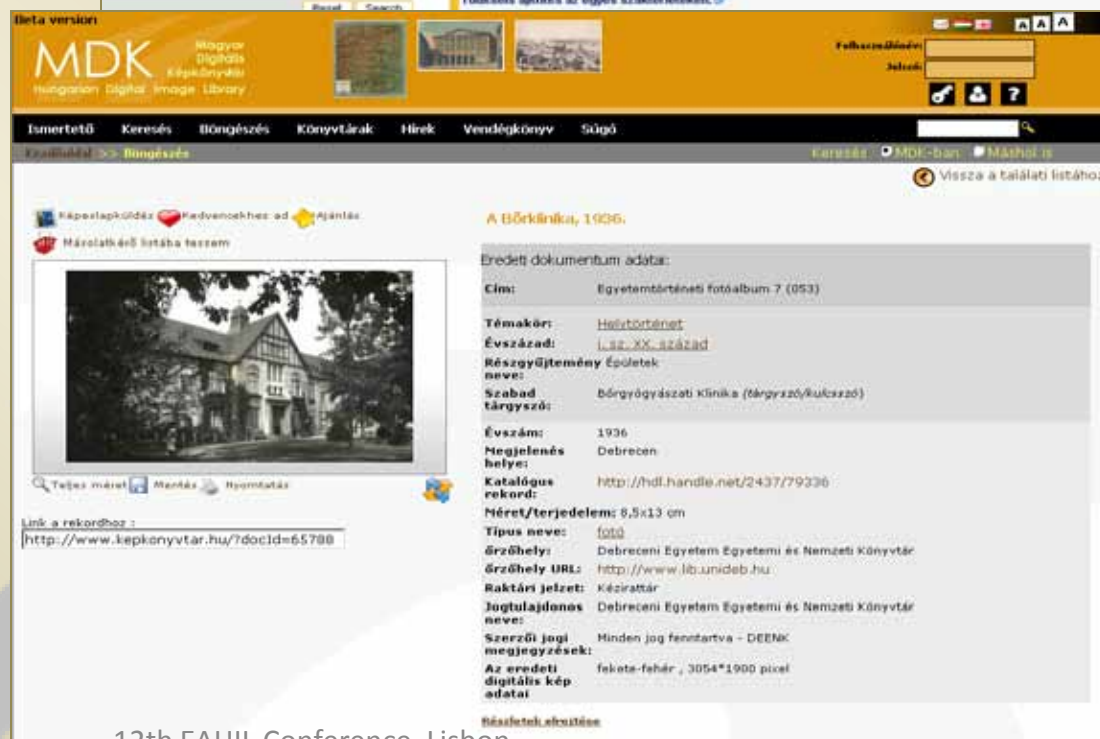
- Bibliographic database

 - E-prints

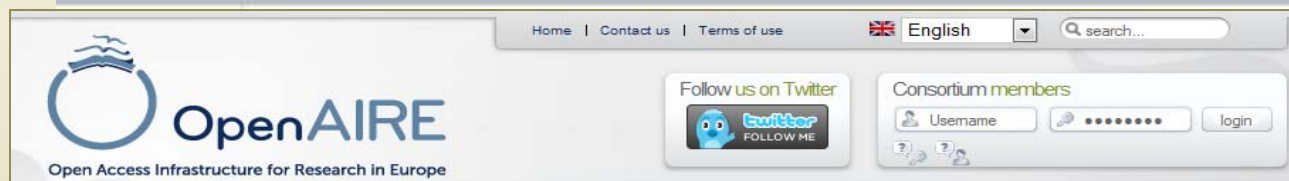
