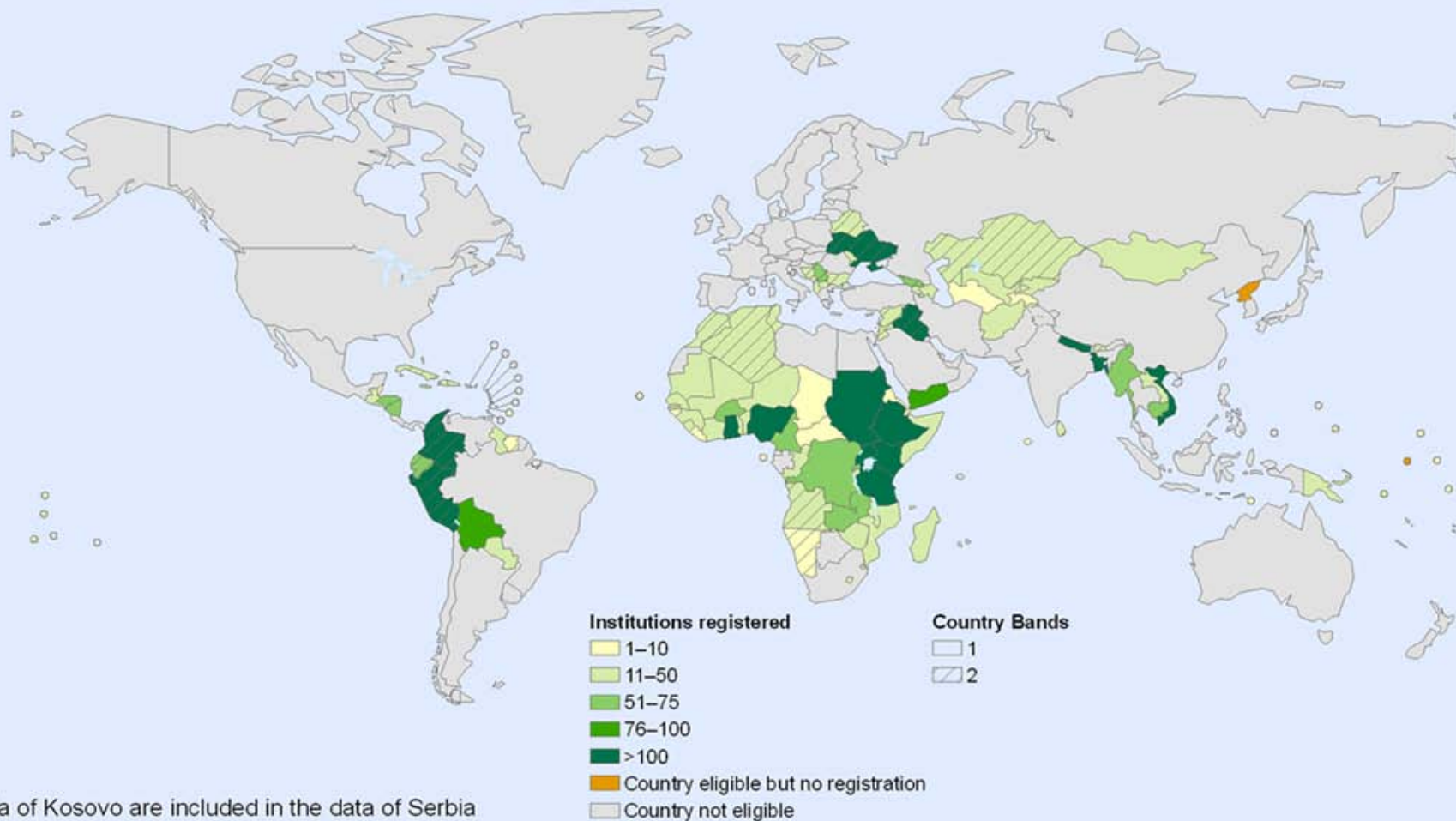
Band Two

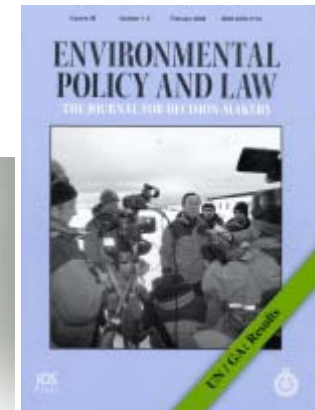

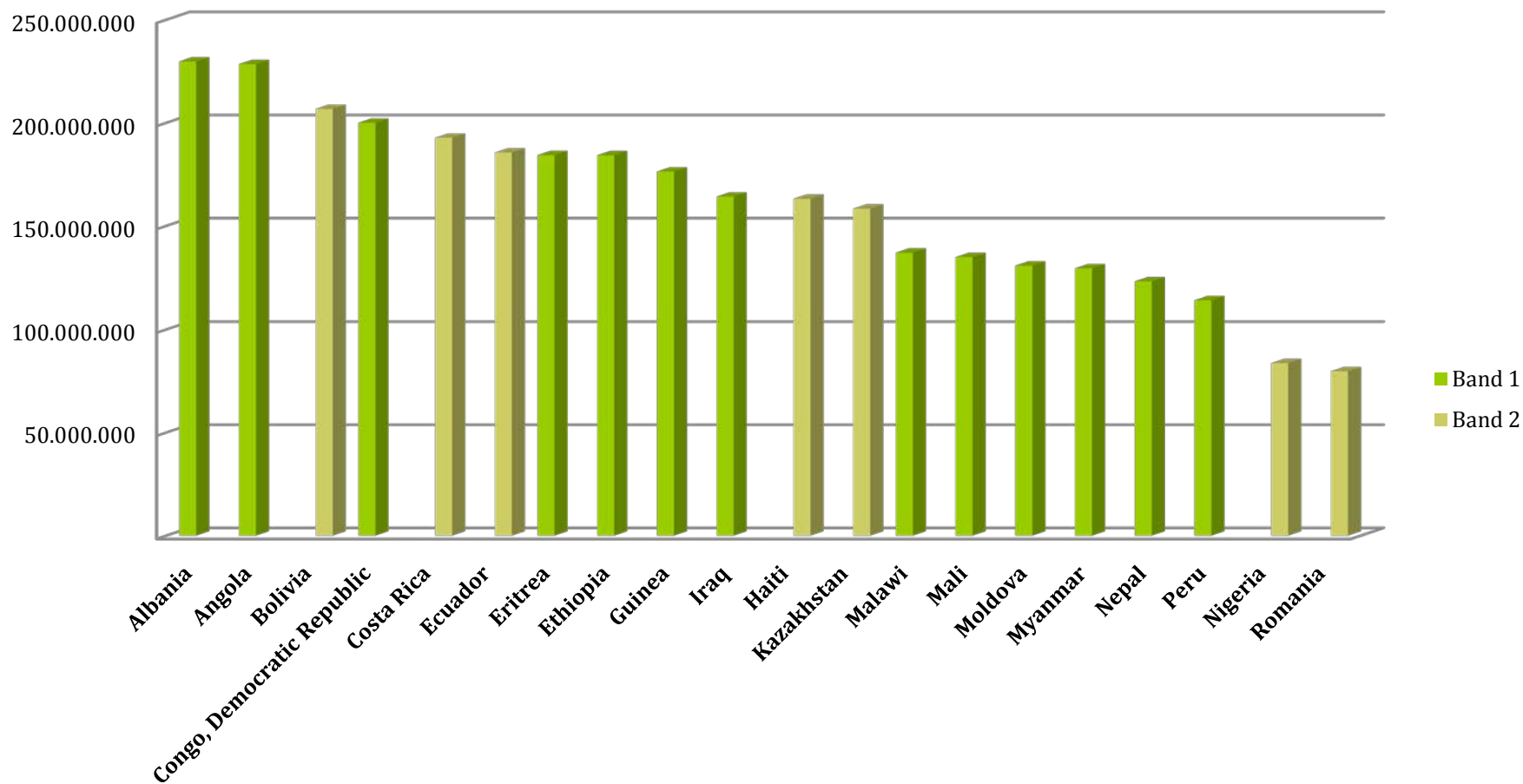
- ❑ 300 publishers, 140 commercial publishers

- ❑ 43 reference sources, 9 with free access



Usage and impact

- ❑ More than 12 Million pages viewed by HINARI users (Band 1) during the period from June 2007 till May 2011.
- ❑ More than 5 Million pages viewed by HINARI users (Band 2) during the period from June 2007 till May 2011.
- ❑ The research output in developing countries increased 194% in five years.

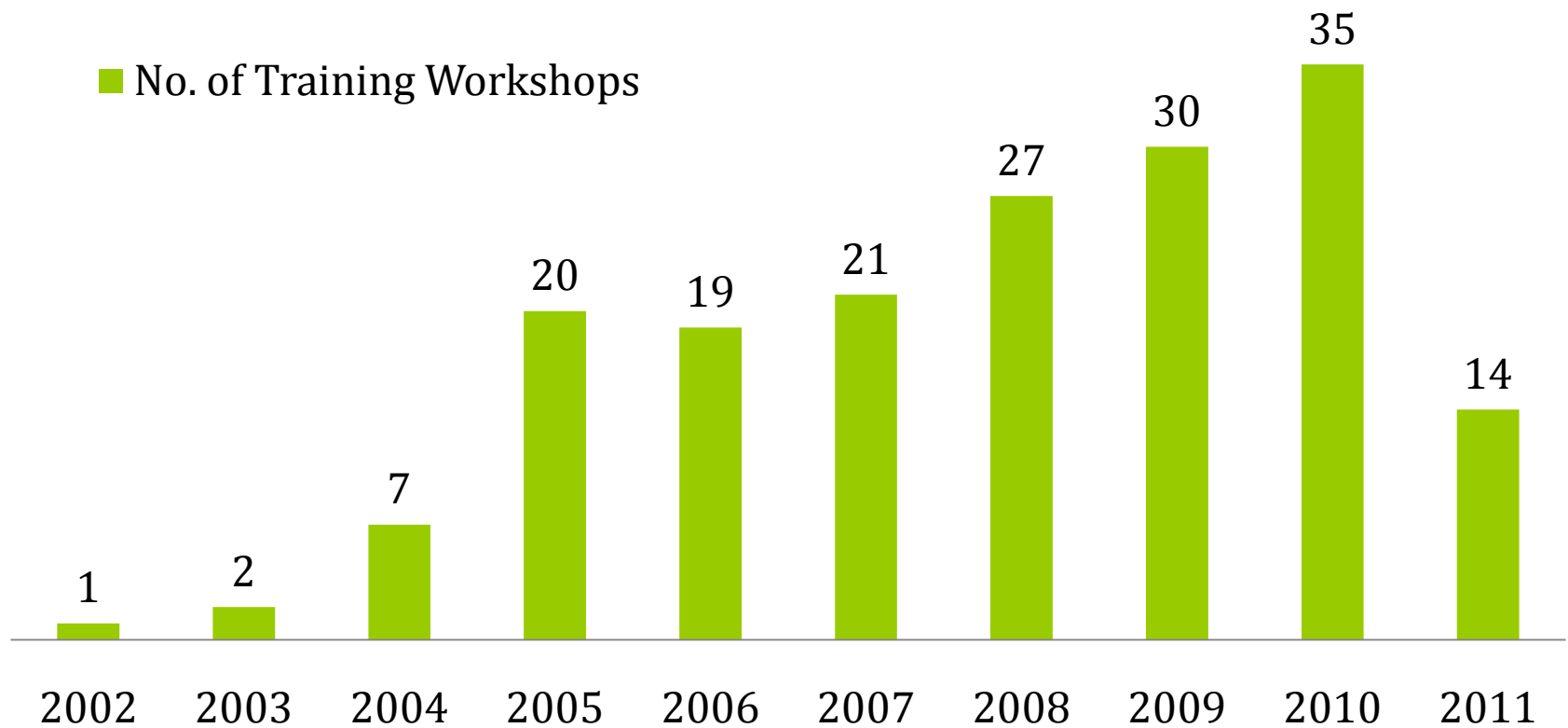

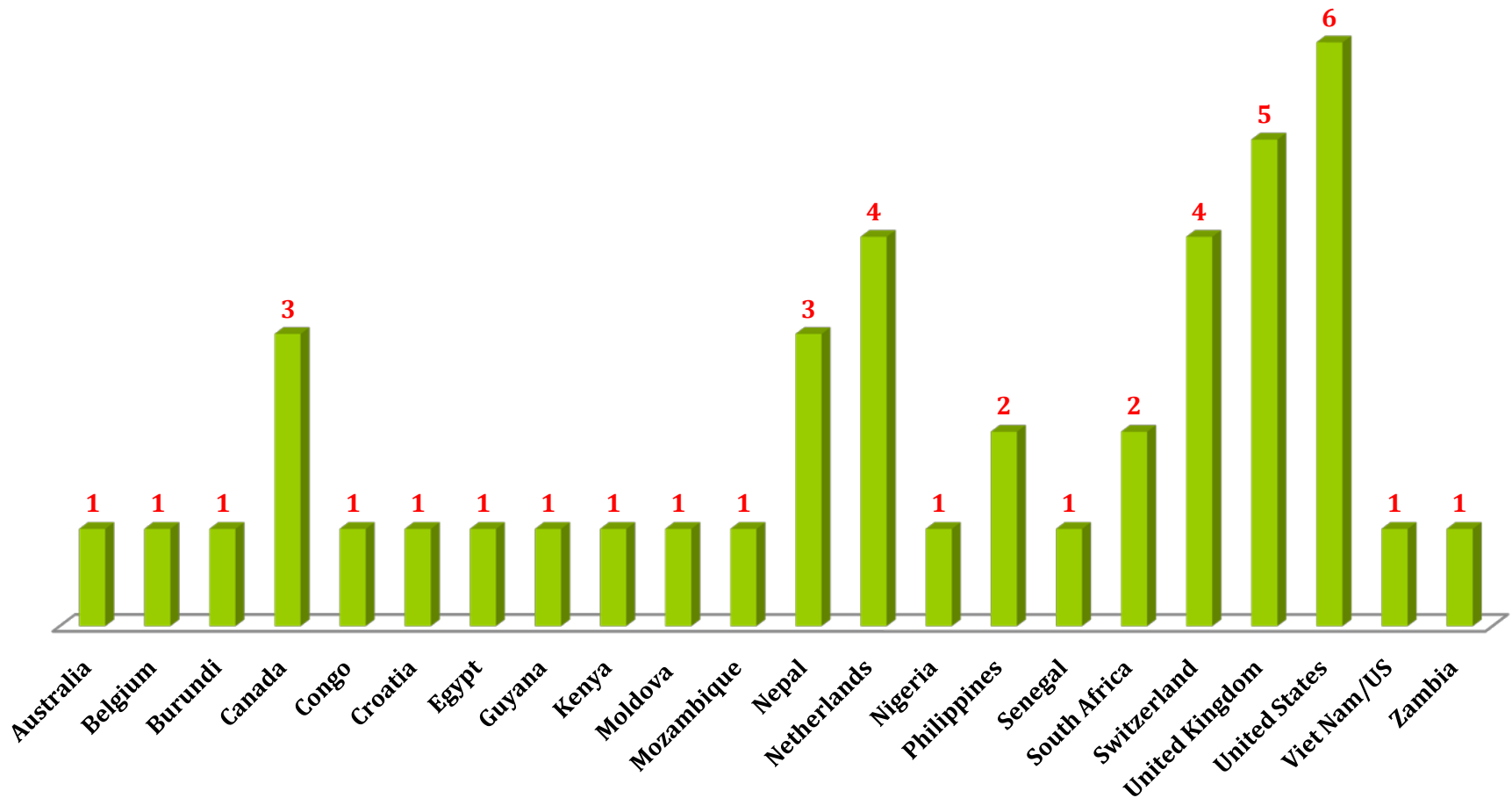
