Band Two

- **38** countries with GNI per capita of \$1250-3500
- AGORA, OARE, and HINARI programs are available for \$1000/year.

4,850 registered institutions (*June 28, 2011*)










Institutions registered with HINARI*




Information resources

- The research output in developing countries increased 194% in five years.










Top 20 HINARI users during 2007-2011

HINARI Access to Research in Health Programme: Train the Trainers Course Teacher: Lenny Rhine

This course will highlight the key features of HINARI (www.who.int/hinari/en/) and related training materials. Also to be discussed are possible sources for workshop funding.

It is geared toward individuals in developed countries that have linkages with HINARI eligible institutions. The participants will be able to instruct individuals from these institutions. This training could be to visitors or graduate students at the participant's home institution or at the partners' sites.












HINARI trainers per country

The Research4Life programmes constitute a public-private partnership between WHO, FAO, UNER Cornell and Yale Universities, more than 130 science publishers led by the International Association of STM Publishers, and technology partner Microsoft. The partnership's goal is to contribute to the attainment of six of the UN's eight Millennium Development Coals, by reducing the gap in scientific knowledge between industrialized countries and the developing world.











Journals by title - all items
