- The Bachelor's Degree in Nursing started in 2009
- The Bachelor's Degree in Physiotherapy started in 2010
- The Bachelor's Degree in Medicine started in 2011

Three main problems

- Gradual implementation
- Different length of studies
- The students are scattered in four Teaching Units

Problems  **opportunities**

- Previous experience in the former Medicine studies
- Satisfying pilot scheme among undergraduate students of Physiotherapy

Students are distributed in four Teaching Units:

1.Santa Creu and Sant Pau Hospital (Barcelona)

1.Vall d'Hebron Hospital (Barcelona)

2.Germans Trias and Pujol University Hospital
(Badalona)

3.Parc Taulí Hospital (Sabadell)

Bachelor's Degree Final Project (TFG)

What does TFG imply for students?

- Put into practice the research methodology
- Intensively use of the library's bibliographic resources
- Be aware of the relevant information means

Four training sessions oriented to the Medicine students:

- Main sources of information in Medicine
- Practical approach to database search
- Bibliographic management tools
- Author's copyright and the TFG

Highly recommended by the teaching staff

Knowing the student's opinion at the end of the training sessions

Brief satisfaction survey :

1. Does the sessions provide you with new insights?
2. Are the explanations clear?
3. In general, is this training useful for you?

In a 5-point scale:

- Where 1 means "I do not agree"
- And 5 means "I totally agree"

Plus space for comments in order to know the students' opinion and their suggestions

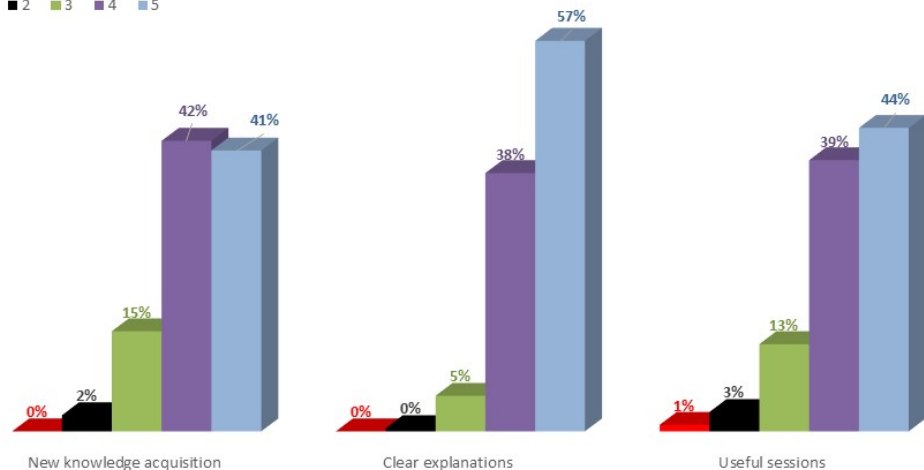
Teaching period: Sept. 2015 / Feb. 2016
