

Bibliographic Managers: A Tool for Document Delivery Service

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COMMON FUNCTIONS BMs:

- Import citations from bibliographic databases and websites.
- Collect metadata from PDF files.
- Organization of citations by topics.
- Annotation of citations.
- Share whole or parts of the Bibliographic Managers (BM) database with colleagues.
- Data interchange with other BMs (e.g., RIS, BibTeX).
- Produce formatted citations in a variety of styles.
- Work with word processing software to facilitate in-text citation¹.

OTHER FUNCTIONS BMs:

- Academic Portfolio².
- Applicable to management of systematic reviews³.
- Use as tool for "Problem-based learning"⁴.
- Bridge between Primary Health Care and Hospital Medical workers⁵.

METHOD:

A pilot test was performed with a small group of researchers (14) who were regular users of the library. Zotero and Mendeley were provided as BMs. During the trial period, the researchers did the literature search and the result was introduced in one of the BMs. Later, they created a group which included the librarian. With the bibliography list provided by the research group, the librarian can search for the complete document and directly share it with the group. After the test, a survey was conducted to assess satisfaction with this system.

WHY NOT TRY AN INTERNAL DOCUMENT DELIVERY SERVICE?

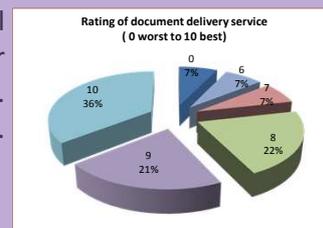
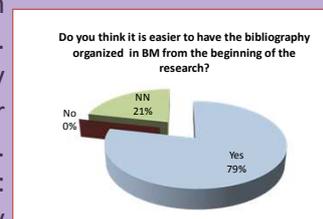
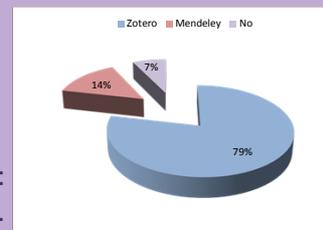
Advantages for researchers:

Organization of the bibliography.
Share bibliography with the research group. Faster reception of full texts.
Fewer errors in the bibliography. Easy compilation of citations for bibliography.

Advantages for librarians:

Fewer errors in citations. No capacity limits for files. Reduced use of email for transferring documents. Faster document delivery service.
Workloads are reduced.
