

Information for digital posters

This is a new format for the conference, and we are excited to see how it goes. There will be a designated time for each poster presentation during break and lunch periods. Presenters will have 20 minutes each to stand and present their poster to conference attendees. The programme organiser will let presenters know which day and time. Approximately eight presentations will be loaded to each of the three totem, and delegates can click a thumbnail of each poster to expand it to a large view.

Technical details

- The file must be jpeg.
- It will need to be in portrait style, with a resolution ratio of 16:9 (if you are doing this in PowerPoint, choose Design, page set-up, and then slide size) or with dimensions of 1920 H pixels X 1080 W Pixels
- Usual best practice for poster design applies to digital posters as well, as far as colour, font, white space, etc.

The posters will be loaded directly to the totem. There will not be any internet connection so please do not include live links in your text.

Please email your poster file by June 22nd. Email reminders will be sent to presenters to help meet the deadline.
